1885 Rhum des Plantations Saint James de la Martinique

The oldest vintage dated rum from the Saint James plantation, bottled in 1952. Saint James originated in Saint-Pierre de la Martinique in 1765, thanks to the Reverend Father Edmund Lefebure, Superior of the Convent of the Brothers of Charity and a skilled alchemist. 1885 was also the year, when the distillery introduced the square bottle — the first in the world. "... it is the flavor that leaves me completely "open mouth". An almost "heavenly" taste, made by an almost perfect balance.
